DIRECTIONS: From the North & East: Follow I-395 to Exit 89. At the bottom of the ramp take a right onto Rt. 14 W. At first light it goes right, then bears left in 1000ft. Follow 5 miles to end. Turn right, still on Rt-14. Continue up the hill to the junction of Rts.14 & 169. Turn right onto Rt.169N. At bottom of hill, take 1st right onto Old Plainfield Rd. Turn in second driveway on left and follow to bottom of hill to field.

From the South: I-395 to Exit 83A. At the bottom of the ramp take a left onto Rt-169 N. Go 10 miles to the center of Canterbury and the Junction of Rt-169 and Rt-14. Go straight ahead on Rt-169N for 1/8 mile and take 1st right onto Old Plainfield Road. Pull in 2nd driveway on left and proceed down hill to field.

From the West: Take Rt.14E from Willimantic area into Canterbury to center of town and the junctions of Rt.14 and Rt. 169. Turn left onto Rt.169N. At bottom of hill, take first right onto Old Plainfield Road. Turn in second driveway on left and follow to bottom of hill to field.
